When do I graduate?

- The course needs to be completed by the student to receive teacher's recommendation. That means each subject area of ELA, Maths, Science and Humanities needs to be completed to a satisfactory level.
- If the graduation criteria were not met, there is an option to continue enrollment for another 10 weeks.
