


## PARENT ONLINE PORTAL — MYSTAMFORD

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### **CAMPUS SECURITY**

At Stamford, we take security very seriously and want to ensure that all parents, guardians, helpers, as well as students and staff, have proper identification needed to enter campus.

### **SECURITY ID CARDS**

Parents, Guardians and Helpers are required to have a Family Security Card. Family cards are limited to 3 per household.

### ▶ How to Apply

You can apply for Family Security Cards on <u>myStamford</u>. Please submit your Card ID application by **20 December 2023**, in order for them to be ready during Orientation Day. For submission received after 20 December 2023, the ID cards will be sent home with your child when it's ready.

### ▶ Photo Requirements

To apply for ID, you will need a digital passport-style photograph. This must be:

- In color, taken against a white background
- In JPG format
- Taken within the last 3 months
- Show the full face

#### Vehicle Access

Vehicles must be registered and car decals must be displayed on the front windshield of your vehicle in order to gain access onto both campuses. Please apply for your Card Decal online. Please apply before 20 December 2023 for your car decal to be ready for collection during Orientation Day. For submissions received after 20 December 2023, the car decal will be sent home with your child when it's ready.

### **BY CAR**

The Early Learning Village campus is located at **3 Chuan Lane** and entrance for cars including those wishing to park, is via **Gate 4.**

### **BUS TRANSPORTATION**

Stamford works with local bus contractor BT & Tan to provide bus services at the Early Learning Village.

#### Please take note:

- Registration for 2023-2024 transportation will be available from 11 December 2023 (Monday) at 8am and will close on 24 December 2023 (Sunday) at 5pm.
- This registration process is compulsory for new riders.
- If you miss the deadline, there will be a 2-week processing time.

### BT & Tan Transport Pte Ltd

The cost for the BT & Tan bus service to/ from Early Learning Village is directly related to the pick-up/drop off address for each student, so is not a predetermined set amount. Please visit myStamford to view sample fares and submit the application for your child.

### **Child Safety Restraints**

Per Stamford Policy, students in Kindergarten 2 and below (all Early Learning Village students) are required to have a Stamford approved Child Safety Restraint (CSR when taking any of our bus services.

They may be purchased online via <u>Taxi Baby</u> or other CSR outlets. Parents may request to have their child's CSR delivered directly to their residence or to the Early Learning Village Transport Office, if purchased from Taxi Baby.

### WOODLEIGH ↔ ELV STUDENT TRANSFER SERVICE

The ELV Student Transfer Bus Service is a complimentary bus service offered only to students who attend the ELV campus. The service allows parents to put their child(ren) on a supervised bus service from the Woodleigh Campus to ELV at the beginning of the school day, and then from ELV back to the Woodleigh Campus at the end of the school day. Child Safety Restraints will be provided by the ELV Transport Office.

This service is provided to Stamford parents who have younger children in the ELV with elder siblings in the Woodleigh Campus, or parents who live nearby the Woodleigh Campus, to make dropoffs and pick-ups of their children at only one location – the Woodleigh Campus.

## STAMFORD NURSING DEPARTMENT

The Stamford Nursing team works directly with school administration to provide an environment that promotes optimal wellness and safety for all students. The Health Center provides individualized quality healthcare for students requiring immediate care. In addition, the Health Center supports health education and promotes a healthy lifestyle for students, staff and families.

### Services provided:

- To develop and implement emergency response plans for all children with moderate/ severe allergies and medical concerns
- To monitor students' immunizations
- To act as a resource for faculty, parents and students
- To provide individual health counseling by servicing emotional and physical health needs, and to refer any appropriate professional community resources as needed
- To evaluate and monitor communicable diseases
- To work closely with the Ministry of Health to ensure standards of best practice
- To conduct health-related classroom instruction
- To provide educational and promotional activities for healthy lifestyles of our students and staff

### WHEN TO STAY AT HOME

Deciding when a child is too unwell for the Infant Care Centre can be difficult. We ask that parents assist by not sending unwell children to the ELV. If you have any concerns regarding your child's health we advise that you seek advice from your physician or any of the Nurses at the school.

If children are unwell during school hours, a Nurse will conduct a medical assessment and provide treatment. If the child is too unwell to remain at Infant Care, the nurse will contact the parent/guardian to make the necessary arrangements for students to be collected. Children are to be collected within 1 hour as per school policy.

Please keep your child at home if unwell and presenting with any of the following:

#### Fever

Defined as above 37.5C as per Singapore Ministry of Health. Children may only return to school after being fever-free for 24 hours WITHOUT the use of fever-reducing medications, such as Panadol or Neurofen.

### ▶ Hand Foot and Mouth Disease (HFMD)

Usually denoted by a fever, sore throat, ulcers in the throat, mouth and tongue. Typically a rash with vesicles (small blisters 3-7mm) on the palms of the hands and soles of the feet are present. Children will not be able to attend ELV and Infant Care until a clearance letter has been obtained from their medical doctor.

### Vomiting and Diarrhea

Vomiting and Diarrhea are commonly caused by viral or bacterial illnesses. Consult a physician for any child who appears dehydrated or has the above symptoms. Children can attend Infant Care 48 hrs after the last episode of vomiting and/or diarrhea.

### ▶ Flu-like Symptoms

Children that present with prolonged coughing and sneezing, are to seek a physician's consultation if no improvement in order to rule out any potential infectious disease i.e Mycoplasma.

### ▶ Impetigo (School Sores)

This is a contagious skin disease characterized by spreading pustular lesions (sores filled with purulent fluid) and medical treatment is required. While in Infant Care, all sores must remain covered. Antibiotic therapy is to be in use for 48 hrs before students can return to school.

### ▶ Head Lice

Head lice are small insects which cause intense itching of the scalp. Children who have active head lice should not come to Infant Care until they have been treated effectively at home. Upon return, the Nurse will ensure that no active head lice remain.

### Conjunctivitis

Presents as itchy, red and inflamed eyes with excessive discharge. Antibiotic treatment needs to be in use before a student can attend the Infant Care Center.



## SCHOOL UNIFORMS

School uniforms are a mandatory requirement for all school students in Singapore. Students must arrive in their school uniforms on the first day of school.

### **UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS**

▶ Shoes and Socks: Students can wear any closed-toe shoes (most students choose trainers) and socks in any color.

Please provide your child with a refillable water bottle labeled with your child's name and class code.


### **STAMFORD CAFES**

## INFANT CARE ROUTINES AND FOOD

### **SLEEP**

Children sleep in dedicated sleep rooms in high or low cots, depending on the child's age and motor skills. Sheets will be provided, however if parents wish to provide an additional barrier to keep the child warm we ask that sleep sacks be provided instead of blankets. Blankets pose strangulation hazard and will be removed from cots. The room temperature sits at the comfortable 24 degree mark. If your child has a pacifier or a comfort toy, you're welcome to send these in too, however due to SIDS precautions, soft toys or pillows will not be permitted in cots under the age of 12 months old.

### **BREAST MILK/FORMULA**

For parents who wish to send Breast Milk or Formula in with their child, a breastmilk fridge is available. Please ensure bottles are labeled with the child's name and store milk/ formula immediately upon arrival.

Staff will feed breast milk/formula according to pre-established feeding plans. There is also a nursing room available.

### Infant Menu - 4 Week

### **FOOD**

For children aged 6 - 18 months, textures will be differentiated ranging from puree to chunky, or a mix of both to accommodate developing chewing skills. Depending on the length of stay for the day, the following meals will be offered: breakfast, morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea and late snack. We also offer "First Solids Menu" to babies just starting on solid foods. The Infant Care Coordinator will work closely with families to ensure a smooth transition onto solids. The school observes a 'nut minimization' policy, so please don't send in any nuts or products containing nuts. Please see an example of the menu below:
