
PARENT ONLINE PORTAL — MYSTAMFORD

CAMPUS SECURITY

At Stamford, we take security very seriously and want to ensure that all parents, guardians, helpers, as well as students and staff, have proper identification needed to enter campus.

SECURITY ID CARDS

Students from Grades 5-12 are required to have a student ID Card. Student ID cards will be issued on the first day of school.

Parents, Guardians and Helpers are required to have a Family Security Card. Family cards are limited to 3 per household.

How to Apply

You can apply for Family Security Cards on <u>myStamford</u>. Please submit your Card ID application by **20 December 2023**, in order for them to be ready during Orientation Day. Any submission after 20 December 2023, please collect from the Community Engagement Center.

▶ Photo Requirements

To apply for ID, you will need a digital passport-style photograph. This must be:

- In color, taken against a white background
- In JPG format
- Taken within the last 3 months
- Show the full face

Vehicle Access

Vehicles must be registered and car decals must be displayed on the front windshield of your vehicle in order to gain access onto both campuses. Please apply before 20 December 2023 for your car decal to be ready for collection during orientation day. Any submission after 20 December 2023, the Community Engagement Center will reach out to you, once ready.

GETTING TO AND FROM SCHOOL

BY CAR

The Woodleigh campus is located at **1 Woodleigh** lane and entrance for cars including those wishing to park, is via **Gate 1**.

BUS TRANSPORTATION

Stamford works with local bus contractor Woodlands Transport Solutions (WTS) to provide bus services at Woodleigh.

To guarantee a seat on the bus, please take note:

- Registration for bus service will close on 26th December 2023. If you are unable to register during this period, you will not be able to start the bus service on 9th January 2024. You will have to start from 15th January 2024 instead.
- This registration process is compulsory for new riders.

STAMFORD NURSING DEPARTMENT

The Stamford Nursing team works directly with school administration to provide an environment that promotes optimal wellness and safety for all students. The Health Center provides individualized quality healthcare for students requiring immediate care. In addition, the Health Center supports health education and promotes a healthy lifestyle for students, staff and families.

Services provided:

- To develop and implement emergency response plans for all children with moderate/ severe allergies and medical concerns
- To monitor students' immunizations
- To act as a resource for faculty, parents and students
- To provide individual health counseling by servicing emotional and physical health needs, and to refer any appropriate professional community resources as needed
- To evaluate and monitor communicable diseases
- To work closely with the Ministry of Health to ensure standards of best practice
- To conduct health-related classroom instruction
- To provide educational and promotional activities for healthy lifestyles of our students and staff

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

School uniforms are a mandatory requirement for all school students in Singapore. Students must arrive in their school uniforms on the first day of school.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

Please see the **graphics overleaf** for a guide to optional and mandatory uniform items for different school sections.

- ▶ Shoes and Socks: Students can wear any closed-toe shoes (most students choose trainers) and socks in any color.
- ▶ BaseballCap: As an alternative to the blue school hat, students at Woodleigh are permitted to wear a Stamford baseball cap. These are available to purchase from the <u>PTAonlineshop</u> once school has started for pick-up or delivery to students or at the Lions Den in Basement 1 on Monday, Wednesday and Friday after school. Students may wear a hat from home for their first week of school whilst waiting for delivery.

MEALS AND CAFES

GRADE 1 TO GRADE 12 AT THE WOODLEIGH CAMPUS

Woodleigh students may choose to pack their own snacks and lunch, pre-order online (recommended for Elementary Students) or purchase directly from the cafe counters (recommended for Secondary Students).

Sodexo is Stamford's Food Services Provider. It is a leading catering provider to schools around the world with a mission aligning with the Stamford Food Philosophy of "Healthy Food, Healthy Kids and a Healthy Planet"

1 Cashless Payment System

In the cafeterias managed by Sodexo, students can use their Stamford student card for easy-to-use, cashless payment. You may top up your child's account online via myStamford or at the cash kiosks located in the cafeterias on campuses. We recommend a minimum top of \$20 to your child's account prior to the first day of school.

2 Semester Meal Plans

Semester meal plans are a pre-paid purchase option for students in Grade 1 to Grade 5 only. Parents may sign up for Semester Meal Plan for their child, which includes a lunch meal for every day of the semester for great convenience & savings. You may sign up the Semester Meal Plan online via myStamford. Sign-ups after the cutoff date will be charged on a pro-rated basis.

Pre-Order Meals

Pre-order meals are available for elementary grades (Grade 1 to Grade 5). All orders are to be placed by 7am on the day of the meal. Parents can select the meals for Elementary students, including beverages and snacks. Pre-orders can be done on a daily, weekly, or monthly basis. There is no pre-order available for Grade 6 to Grade 12. Food offers include an exciting new Mix & Match concept, the Daily Delight, the Grab & Go counter, the Sandwich Counter and the Premium Counter which give students a high degree of flexibility in choosing a lunch.
