Mandatory Academic Field Studies are an additional fee for Grade 3 through Grade 12 Students. These will be included in the invoice of the semester in which they will take place.

Foundational Academic English Program (Online Course)

Stamford American offers a part-time, online Foundational Academic English course for students in Grades 6-10. This 10-week teacher-guided course is designed to help students jump-start their Academic English language learning journey. It prepares them for entry into an international school environment where English is the medium of instruction. This course is intended to be taken alongside full-time courses in their home country.

Annual Technology Fee

This fee provides Information and Communications Technology (ICT) access, insurance and repair as needed for 1-to-1 iPads (KG2-Grade 5), and 1-to-1 MacBook laptops (Grades 6-12). Each iPad and laptop comes with a protective case as the fee covers reasonable usage of the equipment, but will not cover repair costs related to misuse, water damage, screen damage, keyboard damage or physical damage. The technology fee must be paid annually prior to the student's start date, and all ICT resources remain the property of Stamford American. Additional technology funded through this fee include classroom desktop computers, computer labs, Promethean boards, video-conference facilities and the hardware, software and human resources required.



Academic Field Studies (AFS) Fees*

Our Field Studies Program aims to provide a model of holistic, field-based experiential learning. For more information on fees, locations, etc, please refer to our website.

Application Fee*

Applications are considered once the Application Fee is paid. Returning students will not be required to pay the Application Fee if they re-apply within one year of leaving.

Enrollment Fee*

An Enrollment Fee of \$4,000 is payable upon acceptance of an offered place. This is a one-off non-refundable fee payable per successful application.

Facility Fee*

The Facility Fee is payable in full at the time of acceptance in order to secure a place. If payment is not received within 7 calendar days of receipt of the school's invoice, priority will be given to other applicants. The Facility Fee is a one-time administrative fee that is non-refundable. The full amount applies regardless of enrollment date.

* These fees are non-refundable.

Pro-ration

For new families, tuition fees are pro-rated by month if the students begin their course after the academic semester has commenced. Note that the students will be billed for the month they start the school irrespective of start date within the month. Please note that proration is only applicable for tuition fees.

Guardianship

Please note that students under 12 years old must reside with a parent in order to enroll at Stamford American. For students aged 12 and older who will not live with a parent, there are three options for guardianship in Singapore. Please check our website for details.

School Meal Plans: Grade 1 to Grade 12 (Optional)

Payment for school meals and snacks is available for Grade 1 to Grade 12 through topping up of family account via online parent portal MyStamford and kiosk stations on campus. Pre-paid meal plans which covers daily lunch and a beverage are available for students in Grade 1-5 and invoiced on a semester basis.

If a student with meal plans withdraws from school before the end of the semester a pro-rated refund of the unused portion of the meals will be made. Meal plans are not transferable to another student or another semester if not utilized.

Medical Declaration

For the welfare of all students our health office must be informed of any known allergies and other medical concerns. Before attending school, it is mandatory for all students to complete a basic health statement that is provided after an offer is received. It is also important to note that Stamford American employs a nut minimization policy, whereby there are no nuts or nut products allowed in school via the cafeteria or brought in from home.

Immunization Requirements

The Singapore Ministry of Health Department mandates that all students attending school have the required vaccinations: 2 doses of MMR (measles vaccine) taken after the age of 1, and 4 doses of DTaP (diphtheria vaccine). An original copy of the immunization records must be submitted once an offer has been received. All submitted records, if they are in foreign languages, must be translated into English.

Age Guidelines

The date of reference for grade placement by birthdate is September 1st for Nursery through Grade 12. Pre-Nursery applicants must be 18 months old in order to join the school in August, or they may be admitted upon turning 18 months old. Pre-Nursery and Nursery students need not be toilet trained; however, Pre-Kindergarten program applicants must be toilet

Sibling Priority

Stamford American aims to welcome all family members into our community. As such, our first admissions priority is given to families with siblings. Acceptance into grade levels with very limited places will be reserved for children with a sibling or multiple siblings already enrolled at Stamford American or with applications submitted. Siblings will also be given first priority should there be a wait list in their grade level.

Sibling Discounts

A 30% discount on the Enrollment and Facility Fee is available for the application of a third child and a 70% discount on the Enrollment and Facility Fee is available for a fourth child and beyond. A 10% discount on the Tuition Fee is available for a third child and a 20% discount on the Tuition Fee is applicable for a fourth child and beyond. (Discounts are applied from the third child onwards. For example, if there are 3 children in the family, the youngest child will receive the discount.)

Wait List

If a place is not available at the time you wish to join, your child's name will be placed on the wait list and you will be notified as soon as a vacancy is anticipated. Please notify the Admissions Office of any changes of address or other contact details, or if your circumstances change. Wait list priority is given to families with siblings.

Fees are non-transferable. Tuition may be paid annually or in two equal installments by May 1/October 1. Your payment of the fees set out in this letter constitutes your agreement to the fee revisions set out herein. All charges are expressed in Singapore Dollars (SGD) including GST. These fees are payable per student and are adjusted annually. Enrolled students are entitled to a yearbook at the end of the academic year, which is included in the Semester 2 fees. Replacement of lost textbooks, workbooks, library books, iPads, MacBooks and other school resources will need to be funded by the student/family prior to the distribution of additional resources.

International Wire Payments

Stamford American International School has contracted with Flywire, to provide international payers with a convenient way to make payments to the institution. Through Flywire, payers are offered various payment methods, based on the location of their overseas account, competitive exchange rates, and the convenience of paying in their foreign currency. Credit Card Payment Information

(Not applicable for companies)

We accept Visa, Mastercard and American Express credit card payments.

Credit card payments can only be made at the Finance Office at Woodleigh campus by appointment.

We also offer a credit card installment plan for holders of DBS/POSB/AMEX credit cards. At the time of processing, the full amount of the invoice is blocked against the cardholder's credit limit, but it is not actually charged to the card. The block against the credit limit decreases over the six months as the monthly installments are charged to the card by the bank and paid by the cardholder. Terms and conditions apply.

Cash, checks or payments made in other currencies will NOT be accepted.

Payment by Employers or Third Parties

If school fees are to be paid by a company/employer please complete the Letter of Guarantee and submit it to the Admissions Office. An authorized representative from the company/employer will need to sign and stamp this form. Parents are responsible for keeping their company/employer informed of all information regarding Tuition Fee, payment terms and all other fees. Financial responsibility for all school fees remains with the parents irrespective of payments made by third parties.

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

GST at the prevailing rate will be applied to all school fees and will be reflected on your invoice where it applies. Stamford American International School Pte. Ltd. is registered with the Comptroller of Goods and Services Tax. Our registration number is 200823594D. The GST rate established as of January 1, 2024 is 9%.

Singapore Nationality/Singapore Passport Holders

Approval is required from the Ministry of Education (MOE) before a Singaporean student (6 years old and above) is allowed to attend classes at Stamford American. The application for approval from the MOE will be sent as soon as a student is accepted, or as required.

Student Pass

Stamford American will register a child requiring a Student Pass with the Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) after acceptance and parents will process the application from there. Please note that applicants to Stamford American requiring a Student Pass will need formal approval by the ICA. Student Pass holders can commence classes only after the student ID has been issued. Student Pass holders must meet the minimum 90% monthly attendance requirements stipulated by the ICA.

Vaccination Requirements (for age 12 years and below)

The Ministry of Health (MOH) of Singapore has introduced diphtheria and measles vaccination requirements as a prerequisite for foreign-born children applying for long-term immigration passes to Singapore, with effect 1 February 2019.

Foreign-born children aged 12 years old and below, who are first-time applicants for Dependent's Pass (DP) or Long Term Visit Pass (LTVP) issued by the Ministry of Manpower (MOM), and the Student's Pass (STP) issued by the Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA), are required to submit documentary proof of vaccination or evidence of immunity for diphtheria and measles to the Health Promotion Board (HPB) for verification before they can proceed with their applications to MOM or ICA for their long-term stay in Singapore.

Bilingual Language Program

Stamford American offers a Mandarin/English Bilingual Program from Pre-Kindergarten to Grade 5 with the aim to develop students to become Bilingual, Biliterate, and Bicultural through classroom and cultural experiences. The program is based on a 50/50 model of equal exposure to both languages.

All students in this class must be fluent in English and any students that may require additional support either learning or social emotional, are not recommended to join the bilingual class. There is no additional supplementary fee in addition to the Tuition fee, for students partaking in the bilingual program. Enrollment is by application through our Admissions Department. Students in Grade 2 and above are required to sit a Mandarin language proficiency test prior to acceptance.

English as an Additional Language (EAL)

Students who are determined as potential English language learners undergo an English language assessment upon application. For those requiring additional English language support, the EAL fees are mandatory and are in addition to the standard tuition fees.

Support for Learning

The Student Support Department aims to provide support to faculty and students so that every student achieves more than they believe they can regardless of any academic, physical, development and/or social-emotional challenge they may experience.

We utilize an RtI Model of support which is a systematic and data-based method for identifying, defining, and resolving students' academic and/or behavioral difficulties which means we offer a tiered continuum of support. The needs of eligible students will be assessed on an individual basis and parents should discuss their situation with the Admissions Office Prior to making an application for enrollment.

The fees for support can range from no additional costs to the following per quarter:

Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs)

Stamford American provides a robust CCA program of over 350 activities for students from Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 12 that happen outside of the classroom before, during and after school hours. The program covers a wide selection of interests including sports, fine and performing arts, academic support, languages, and technology. 75% of the activities offered are free of charge to Stamford American students, whilst the remaining 25% are vendor based paid programs outsourced to expert vendors handpicked through a careful selection process. CCAs are offered in 3 Seasons which are aligned with the ACSIS Athletics Seasons. For all queries, please contact cca@sais.edu.sg

Stamford-Student Contract

The Stamford-Student Contract is an important legal document between the school and each student, that details the Course Information and Fees, Refund Policies, Fee Protection Scheme (FPS) by LONPAC Insurance Pte Ltd, Medical Insurance Scheme by Sime Darby Insurance Brokers (Singapore) Pte Ltd and American International Assurance Company Limited. etc. Execution of this contract before a student starts school is a legislative requirement of the Committee for Private Education and provides extra protection for Stamford American students.



Deferment of acceptance

Once a student is accepted and the Facility Fee has been paid, a place is secured. Should it be necessary, a student may defer their school start date for the next consecutive semester or up to one year from the initial start date indicated in the acceptance letter. Deferred applications will undergo another review process and will be subject to availability for the new start date. After a one year deferment, the application will no longer be valid and the student will need to re-apply. If for any reason, acceptance is cancelled by the family before starting school, the Application, Enrollment and Facility Fee will not be refunded. For additional information see "Cancellation of Acceptance."

Cancellation of Acceptance

If, for any reason, parents cancel their acceptance of a place before the student starts at Stamford American, the Application, Enrollment and Facility Fee will not be refunded. Tuition Fees paid in advance will be refunded provided the Admissions Office has been notified prior to the Withdrawal Notice dates: June 1 for Semester 1 and November 1 for Semester 2. For cancellation after the student's commencement, please refer to Withdrawals below.

Notice of WIthdrawal

Kindly note that students currently enrolled in the school, but not returning in the following semester should notify the school by June 1 for Semester 1 and November 1 for Semester 2.

School Changes

This school, as any other, is likely to undergo a number of changes during the time your child is here. For example, there may be changes in the staff, in the premises, facilities and their use, in the curriculum, the size and composition of classes, the Handbook, the Terms and Conditions, the disciplinary framework and the length of the school year. Tuition and school fees will be regularly reviewed and adjusted annually.
