#### **ACADEMIC COURSE OFFERINGS**

Academic counseling begins for students in Grade 9 to support students in identifying and shaping their learning programs both at Stamford and beyond.

#### PREPARATORY COURSE FOR SECONDARY (PCS)

Grade 6 to 10 students who are English Language Learners may join Stamford by first attending our intensive Preparatory Course for Secondary program (PCS), in order to improve their academic English to meet the rigor of the secondary curriculum. Students may study either one or two semesters within PCS before joining the middle school or high school in their appropriate grade level program.

# **GRADES 9 & 10 - IB MIDDLE YEARS PROGRAMME** (IB MYP)


All students in Grades 9 and 10 are enrolled in the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme (IB MYP), as a part of the IB Continuum at SAIS. As MYP students, our Grade 10s have the option to pursue an IB-validated MYP Certificate, individual MYP Course Certificates. Throughout the programme, our students engage in contexts and approaches to learning as a tool for academic success. Grade 10 students may also be eligible to choose the flexible MYP pathway (MYP Flex), choosing one (1) AP course within their student schedule. This allows students to continue learning in the MYP while beginning to explore options for a more flexible pathway in Grades 11 and 12.

# GRADES 11 & 12 (US HS DIPLOMA VIA IB DIPLOMA PATHWAY OR INDIVIDUALIZED PATHWAY)

IBDP, BTEC and Stamford courses are available for students in Grades 11 and 12. AP courses are available to students in Grades 11 and 12, with a few courses open to students in Grade 10. Stamford students are limited to taking a maximum of 4 advanced courses per year (AP and IB HL courses). Full IB Diploma students are restricted to three Higher Level courses. Students in Grades 11 and 12 have the option to pursue the full IB Diploma or an individualized academic pathway. Stamford is the first and only school in Singapore to concurrently offer the American Advanced Placement, BTEC International Level 3 and International Baccalaureate Diploma Curricula.

#### **INDIVIDUALIZED PATHWAY**

Stamford American students have the opportunity to take a blend of IB, BTEC, AP and/or Stamford College Preparatory courses to work towards the Stamford US High School Diploma. This offers flexibility and choice for students in the content and rigor of their programs of study. Students in the Individualized Pathway also have the opportunity to take external IB or AP examinations. Students in the BTEC Diploma are more restricted to the courses they may take depending on the type of BTEC diploma they are working towards.

#### **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

Total minimum credits to graduate is 24 credits: 1 credit equals 1 academic year of study + attendance requirement.

The majority of students will graduate in excess of the minimum graduation credit requirements. The Stamford Diploma represents eight semesters of study. Students may not graduate early even if all credits are met. Students must also meet attendance and service requirements each year as part of their graduation pathway.

#### **GRADING AND REPORTING**

Progress grades are reported semesterly, and only end-of-year grades are reported on the transcript. Stamford American uses the IB 1-7 grading scale for Stamford, PCS, MYP and IBDP courses, the AP 1-5 scale for AP courses, and the BTEC D\*-U scale. IB Theory of Knowledge is reported as a P (Pass) or F (Fail). Due to the semester-based program within PCS, students graduating after only one semester of study will receive 0.5 credit per course for their semester of study in PCS. If they join the high school for the second semester, then they can earn 0.5 credit per course within the MYP program.

### **IBDP RESULTS | CLASS OF 2025**

IB Diploma candidates must also complete the IBDP Core, which consists of Theory of Knowledge (TOK), Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS), and the Extended Essay (EE). Stamford HS Diploma students can choose to pursue IBDP Course Certificates, enabling them to sit selected IBDP examinations and not complete the IBDP Core.


